.20 ASSIGNMENTS:

1. **Baker Park Event: Refer to Annex B – ICS 203 & 204 Forms**
 - A. Lieutenant Michael Lee, Commander, Special Operations Division, has been designated the Incident Commander for this detail.
 - B. Sgt. Angela Waechter has been designated the the Chief of Operations for this detail.
 - C. Baker Park will be divided into two (2) Divisions and three (3) Teams for the purpose of span of control:
 1. Division 1 - N. Bentz St. to College Ave
Supervisor: Sgt. Waechter
Team 1: The area between N. Bentz St and College Ave.
 2. Division 2 – College Ave to W. College Terrace
Supervisor: Lt. Tokarz
Team 2: College Ave. to W. College Terrace

Team 3: Parkway Elementary and surrounding streets.

3. Bike Patrol: Sgt. M. Carrado will supervise and distribute officers throughout the Baker Park Event.
 - Bike Units should monitor Culler Lake and the Volleyball tournament at Frederick High School and west of Culler Lake.

2. Baker Park Event (Post Fireworks):

- A. Lt. Tokarz will monitor the Post Fireworks Baker Park Detail

3. Traffic Event (Post Fireworks): **Refer to Annex D – Traffic Assignments**

- A. Sgt. Waechter will monitor Traffic Operations at the end of the event.

- B. Officers assigned to Traffic Operations need to familiarize themselves with Annex D and additional responsibilities of their assignment.

.30 STREET CLOSURES, BARRICADES, AND NO PARKING AREAS:

1. No Parking Designations and Enforcement:

- A. No Parking Signs will be placed NLT July 1, 2017 by Parking Department personnel.
- B. On Monday, July 3, 2016 the supervisor of Patrol Squad "D" will assign officers to assist the parking department with towing vehicles from the designated "NO PARKING" areas. **Refer to Maps in Annex E.**

2. Barricades/Vehicle Placement:

- A. The Supervisor of Patrol Division Squad "G" will ensure barricades located at the below listed intersections are erected by 0700 on July 4, 2016. Additionally, the traffic signal at the intersection of W. 2nd St. and College Ave. will need to be placed on flash, rather than normal cycle, at the same time the street is barricaded. Due to the scheduled events in Baker Park, the areas within these barricades will be closed between 0700 and the conclusion of the day's events.
- B. Sergeant Angela Waechter, Supervisor, Outreach Unit, or her designee, will ensure that the barricades and cones at the locations listed in Annex F are erected by the Baker Park detail at the times and locations noted.
- C. Large vehicles will be strategically placed in order to provide protection and security to pedestrians within the Fredericks Fourth event.

1. W. 2nd St. – Between N. Bentz St. and College Ave.

5. Carroll Parkway – Between College Ave and N. Jefferson St.

A dispatcher will be assigned for the event and will be assigned to the MCU.

.50 LOGISTICAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. The Department's Mobile Command Unit (MCU) will be parked in the 100 blk. of College Ave. The MCU deployment will be coordinated with the supervisors of Squad "B" or "G" and will be placed NLT 0900hrs.
2. Police vehicles will be parked at strategic locations surrounding Baker Park. There are police only parking signs on N. Bentz St in the area of the Tally Rec Center.
 - a. The following Officers will park their vehicles at the noted locations for the duration of the event as a security measure to increase pedestrian safety.
 - b. Division 1 Supervisor will staff the vehicle with one officer at W. 2nd St. and N. Bentz St. as this vehicle may need to be moved periodically for event personnel or in case of emergency. It is recommended that officers are rotated through this assignment.

.55 CRIME, CROWD AND TRAFFIC EXPECTATIONS:

1. Crime problems are generally post-fireworks and can be expected to include disorderly conduct, disorderly intoxication and mutual assaults resulting from fights. The Baker Park detail will handle these incidents should they occur, unless they are unable to do so because of the volume of calls for service and/or traffic corners. If the detail is unable to handle an incident in the park, the on-duty Patrol Division Supervisor will be consulted for assistance by the Incident Commander.
2. It is anticipated that post-fireworks traffic egress from Baker Park will be *extremely* heavy and slow. Personnel will be directed to move traffic away from the park and toward roadways specifically designed to accommodate heavy volumes of traffic (i.e., Interstate and U.S. highways), absent exigent circumstances precluding the use of one or more of these roadways.
3. Prisoner Transport: The Frederick County Adult Detention Center will provide two officers and a prisoner transport van for the duration of the event. The prisoner transportation detail will be located with the Command Post.
5. Quick Reaction Force (QRF) Support: The SCU and DEU have been designated as a quick reaction force to support and address emergency situations at either the Fredericks Fourth event or the Barbara Fritchie Races. The QRF could also supplement traffic assignments in the event specialty units need to respond to another incident in the city. These personnel will be deployed when requested and at the direction of LT Pennington. The quick reaction force's responsibilities and duties will be covered under a special order.

.60 FIREWORKS LINE:

1. At approximately 0900hrs, Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) will place stakes in the park between Carroll Creek and the public pool outlining the fireworks line and enabling FPD personnel to place police tape to restrict the area.
2. The staging area will be on Parkway Elementary School property and extend to the bike path just north of Carroll Creek from College Avenue to the suspension bridge in Baker Park.
 - a. FPD personnel assigned to Team 2 will attach police tape indicating the border designated by the State Fire Marshal's Office that restricts access to the staging area of the fireworks display north of Carroll Creek in the park. Ensure that no spectators are allowed within this area other than to utilize the bike/walking path.

- b. FPD personnel assigned to Team 3 will place police tape around Parkway Elementary indicating the border designated by the State Fire Marshal's Office that restricts access to the staging area for the fireworks display.
- c. Sworn personnel will be assigned to maintain security of the perimeter tape to restrict access. Officers assigned to perimeter security will close access to the bike/walking path utilizing police tape or barricades. At approximately 1100hrs OFC Herman will place police tape on the stakes at the perimeter of the fireworks line.

.65 LOST CHILDREN:

1. Officers encountering lost children will immediately broadcast all relevant information to detail personnel. The information would minimally include the description and name of the child, and parent, and location where the child was found. After a brief search of the immediate area where the child was located, the lost child will be escorted to the Mobile Command Unit.
2. Reports of lost children by parents/guardians will result in an immediate broadcast of the child's description, name, and last known location. The reporting parent will be encouraged to respond to the command post.

.70 PUBLIC OUTREACH COORDINATOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

Lieutenant Michael Lee will serve as the Public Outreach Coordinator for the event. He will ensure that a timeline for dissemination of information relative to the July 4th Celebration is established and followed so citizens can be informed about the event and its impact on them. Ms Michelle Bowman will be the Social Media Outreach Coordinator for the event at the Mobile Command Post. Public Outreach Activities for the event are attached as Annex A of this order.

The Team leader is to break the team into two sections to maintain mobile patrol throughout the entire park. One section will patrol Division 1 and one section will patrol Division 2 area. Officers are expected to spread out in their assigned Division area and not congregate in large groups. <u>At 2100hrs Officers will move to their secondary assignments (Post Firework Security or Traffic Operations) and report to the section supervisor.</u> 							
SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS/SAFETY MESSAGE							
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any unsafe situations should be reported through the chain of command immediately. Personnel should be aware of changing/unsafe weather conditions, take shelter in the event of severe weather. Personnel will stay hydrated and monitor each other for signs of fatigue or heat related illness. Special attention should be given to the intersection of Dulaney Ave and W. 2nd St at the conclusion of the fireworks display for disorderly persons, mutual assaults, etc. Supervisors will ensure that they park an adequate number of emergency vehicles on the north side of 2nd St, west of College Ave in the restricted parking spaces reserved. This will enable them to respond to other locations within the city if necessary.

.55 CRIME, CROWD AND TRAFFIC EXPECTATIONS:

1. Crime problems are generally post-fireworks and can be expected to include disorderly conduct, disorderly intoxication and mutual assaults resulting from fights. The Baker Park detail will handle these incidents should they occur, unless they are unable to do so because of the volume of calls for service and/or traffic corners. If the detail is unable to handle an incident in the park, the on-duty Patrol Division Supervisor will be consulted for assistance by the Incident Commander.

2. It is anticipated that post-fireworks traffic egress from Baker Park will be *extremely* heavy and slow. Personnel will be directed to move traffic away from the park and toward roadways specifically designed to accommodate heavy volumes of traffic (i.e., Interstate and U.S. highways), absent exigent circumstances precluding the use of one or more of these roadways.
3. Prisoner Transport: The Frederick County Adult Detention Center will provide two officers and a prisoner transport van for the duration of the event. The prisoner transportation detail will be located with the Command Post.
5. Quick Reaction Force (QRF) Support: The SCU and DEU have been designated as a quick reaction force to support and address emergency situations at either the Fredericks Fourth event or the Barbara Fritchie Races. The QRF could also supplement traffic assignments in the event specialty units need to respond to another incident in the city. These personnel will be deployed when requested and at the direction of LT Pennington.
